Archil Karaulashvili - born in Telavi, Georgia, 1973.

In 1995 he was graduated from the Faculty of International Economic Relations of Iv. Javakhishvili State University.

He started his career on the State Committee of Foreign Relations of Georgia in 1995 as a Chief Specialist. From 1996 until 2000 he worked as a Head of Division of Business-Plan Analysis and as a Deputy Head of the Department of Foreign Investment, Credits and Inter-branch Projects at the Ministry of Trade and Foreign Economic Relations of Georgia.

In 2000-2004 he was a Director of the Investment Policy Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Georgia.

For the 2004-2015 period he served as a Head of the European Integration Coordination Department at the Office of the State Minister of Georgia on European and Euro-Atlantic Integration.

From March 2015 to December 2017, Archil Karaulashvili was a First Deputy State Minister of Georgia on European and Euro-Atlantic Integration.

From March 2018 he is a Director General for European Integration in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Georgia. He is also a Secretary to the Governmental Commission for the EU Integration.

In 2011, Mr. Karaulashvili was awarded with an Order of Honor.

Is a co-author of books and articles on the European Integration.
